



The Great Book Swap at Leura Public School

Dear Parents,

Leura Public School in conjunction with Leura Public School P&C, have chosen the Indigenous Literacy Foundation as a focus for charitable fundraising. Our contribution will be through **The Great Book Swap**, which will be held at school on Thursday 20th of June.

The Great Book Swap is a simple fundraising idea. All the funds raised go to support the important work of the Indigenous Literacy Foundation. Students and staff donate one of their favourite books and pay a gold coin donation to swap it for someone else's book.

Here's how it works:

-  Choose a book (or books) you loved reading but are ready to let go to a new home. Next, fill in the bookplate below to tell its new owner why you loved it.
-  Bring in your chosen book/s, along with a gold coin for each book you have chosen to donate to the Great Book Swap. Coins will be collected by your classroom teacher. The books will be handed to your classroom teacher and placed in a Great Book Swap Box in your classroom.
-  In return for your book and coin donation, you will be given a voucher to choose a book at the Great Book Swap. Teachers will make a record of donated books and distribute the vouchers on the Thursday morning prior to the Great Book Swap.
-  Students will exchange their voucher/s at the GREAT BOOK SWAP
 - K-2 Great Book Swap before lunch in the Hall.
 - Years 3-6 Great Book Swap after lunch in the Hall.

All money raised will be donated to the Indigenous Literacy Foundation.
