1/2: 3.45pm – 4.15pm (in 1/2 Angelfish room – Mrs Aldred)

3/4: 4.15pm – 4.45pm (in 2/3 Fur Seals room – Mrs Forrester)

Wednesday 13 February

5/6: 3.15pm – 3.45pm (in 5/6 Albatross room – Mr Atkinson)

All sessions will start with the teachers across the stage together. Some may choose to move into individual classrooms if this is relevant for their stage.

The P&C will kindly be providing afternoon tea (for a gold coin donation) from 3.00-4.30pm on Tuesday outside the canteen so please pop in for some refreshment.

We are offering supervision of school-aged children during each session, if you are unable to make alternative arrangements. This supervision will be available in the library between 3.15pm and 4.45pm on Tuesday only. Children will be able to use the computers, read a book or engage in their own activity from home, while you attend the information session.
