The Leura Public School **Cross Country Carnival** will be held in the school grounds on **Wednesday, 5<sup>th</sup> August.** The carnival will involve all K-6 students. Should the weather be inclement on the day, the carnival will be postponed to Wednesday, 12<sup>th</sup> August.

It is a whole school event where active participation for all will be encouraged. Students will be seated in House Groups and asked to wear their **sports uniform**, **sensible running shoes, sunscreen and hats.** Please ensure students **bring a water bottle**. Prior to the event, students will walk the course to familiarise themselves with the track. Students are welcome to carry their water bottles with them and a puffer if required.

Students will participate in one long distance running event on the day. Students aged between 5 - 7 will be completing a shorter track around the playground. Students aged **8**, **9 and 10 will run 2.0km**. Students aged **11**, **12 and 13 will run 3.0km**.

Due to current operational guidelines with regard to COVID-19, we are unable to welcome parents and extended families on site. This is disappointing as we all appreciate the assistance each year from our community to run this event.

The Zone Cross Country Carnival has been cancelled this year following advice from NSW Primary School Sports Association.
