## Stage 3: Great Aussie Bush Camp 2021

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

We are all extremely excited about our upcoming Stage 3 camp, at the beginning of Term 3. Here is some important information for the camp:

**Dates:** Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> July to Friday 30<sup>th</sup> July 2021

**Accommodation**: Great Aussie Bush Camp – Kincumber. Ph: 1800 887 717

**Medications:** All medication must be given to the classroom teacher in an enclosed bag with

student's name clearly written on it.

**Permission forms:** Please find attached *Medical and Dietary forms* which are required to be completed and <u>returned to school by Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June at the latest.</u>

**Transport, Departure and Return times:** Transport to and from the camp will be in a coach fitted with seat belts. Departure time from school will be 8.30am on Wednesday. All children need to be at school by 8.00am sharp. We expect to return to school on Friday by approximately 3:30pm.

**Travel Sickness:** Students prone to travel sickness should take the usual precautions prior to travelling. Sufficient medication should be supplied for the return journey if required. Please record information regarding medication on the attached *Medical form*.

**Behaviour:** Teachers always have high expectations for good behaviour from all our students at school and on all excursions and camps. Students are expected to follow all directions safely and respectfully throughout the camp.

**Health and Safety:** The attending staff members with emergency care training and CPR are Mrs Farrell and Mrs Manwaring. Camp team members also have First Aid and Resuscitation certificates. Great Aussie Bush Camp has a current Covid safety plan in place.

Please read the attached *Camp Guidelines and Rules* and discuss with your child. There is also a Gear Checklist for what to bring. We encourage children to pack their own bags so that they can re-pack their belongings for the return trip. Every effort will be made to ensure that all students have a safe, enjoyable and memorable experience at the Great Aussie Bush Camp.
