Thank you for choosing Primary Ethics for your child's SRE/SEE time.

Sadly, we have lost a number of volunteer Ethics Teachers this year. At this stage, in 2021 we may only be able to offer three (3) Ethics classes across the whole school. There is a very strong chance that your child will not be placed in an Ethics class but will instead have to go to non-Scripture.

We are looking for more volunteers so that we can provide Ethics classes for all the families who have requested it for their children.

Ethics teachers receive full training by *Primary Ethics*, the not-for-profit organisation approved to design curriculum and training for the Ethics program. Training is provided, as are lesson materials. Suitable volunteers have an interest in children's education and development of critical thinking skills but you do <u>NOT</u> need to have previous teaching experience.
