Frequently Asked Questions – 20th May 2020
Return to School Week 5 Term 2

Leura Public School is returning to full on-campus learning from Monday 25th May.

All school activities and operations will be in line with [Australian Health Protection Principal Committee \(AHPPC\)](#) and [NSW Health Guidelines](#) as applicable.

The Department of Education has provided [Guidelines for Parents and Carers](#) to assist students and families return to full time face-to-face learning.

The guidelines have been used to inform these Frequently Asked Questions.

Is school full time in Week 5?

- Yes. All students should attend school 5 days a week from next week, Monday 25th May.

Will there be home learning plans provided?

- No. Teaching will be delivered in the classroom and as a result home learning plans are not required.

How will my child's learning be supported at school?

- Students will be taught by their teacher in their classroom. Students in 1/2B will continue, until week 7, to be taught by Mrs Cunneen.

Will the school canteen be open in Week 5?

- No, the canteen will be closed until further notice. Students should come to school with their recess, lunch, fruit and a refillable water bottle.
- Students will be able to fill their own water bottles in the classroom and where any taps are located.

Will the school canteen be open during Term 2 at all?

- The school canteen may be open later in the term. We will update you if the decision is made to open the canteen one day a week.

Are student reports being issued for Semester 1?

- Yes. Students have been assessed during the first half of 2020 and a written report will be issued.
- This report is a simplified version to what would normally be issued, as schools have been given flexibility to modify reports based on adjustments to learning during this time.

Will there be assemblies?

- No. Assemblies have been cancelled until further notice.

Does my child still need to bring a drink bottle?

- Yes. Students are not able to drink from a water bubbler at school. They can refill their water bottle at the tap.

Can visitors (including parents) come onto the school site?

- No. There should be no visitors to school sites unless they are essential (such as allied health/case management professionals and maintenance providers).
- P&C meetings and parent/carer meetings should be conducted virtually where possible.

Can students play sport?

- Yes, so long as it is non-contact sport.

When does my child bring their library bag now?

- Each class will resume their original library day that was established in Term 1. Communicate via Class Dojo with your child's teacher if you need a reminder of the day.

What if my child is sick?

All students should be at school unless:

- They have a medical certificate which states that they are unable to return to school due to an ongoing medical condition.
- They are currently unwell.

What if I have a question that is not answered here?
