Leura Public School Instrumental Music Program 2021

Gain all of the academic, emotional and social benefits that learning an instrument can provide!

- Instrumental Music Program is open to students in Years 3 to 6.
- Students start with lessons and join the Beginner band.
- When their playing develops to the appropriate level they then move into the Senior band.
- Beginner band rehearses on Wednesdays at Recess 1:30pm – 2:00pm.
- Senior band rehearses on Wednesdays 2:00pm – 3:00pm.
- Leura Public School has a full set of excellent instruments for hire or students can use their own privately owned instrument. Students in the percussion group hire a drum pad for practice at home.
- The instruments currently available are listed on the attached Expression of Interest (EOI) form.

COSTS:

Please Note: All fees are payable prior to the start of each term. If a student decides to leave the program, they do so at the end of a school term, and incur costs of the full term.

Directors Fee:

- \$35 per term for all students helps cover the costs of running the Instrumental Music Program.

Instrument Hire:

- \$50 per instrument per term.
- Percussion – drum pad \$5 per term.
- The fee covers instrument maintenance and replacement costs.
- Instruments will need be returned to the school for brief maintenance annually.

Small Group Tuition Fee:

- The cost is \$135 per student per term (9 lessons).
- One extra lesson per term is provided to cover missed lessons (if any).
- This fee covers the employment of instrument tutors. We cannot reduce it to account for repeated student absence.
- If absences by tutor reduce our available lessons, the school will adjust fees accordingly. Tutors will contact parents directly in this event.
- Parents are requested to contact tutors directly if their child will be missing a lesson.
- Tentative indications of small group tuition times are:
 - Flute, Clarinet and Saxophone – Mondays and Wednesdays at recess or after school.
 - Trumpet, Trombone, Euphonium – Tuesdays after school.
 - Percussion – Thursdays at recess or after school.
- Small group tuition lesson length is determined by how many students per group.

Private Tuition:

- If group tuition times do not suit, parents are welcome to seek out individual lessons, either with tutors from our program or elsewhere, at privately arranged rates.

Please note: Outstanding fees from previous terms must be fully paid for students to continue with the program the following term.
