Firstly, we would like to thank all our parents for their incredible diligence around student illness at this time. As we know, students should never be at school if they are sick and we thank you for always being supportive of this and arranging care for your children if they need to remain home from school. In the current climate our school is being extremely cautious around student illness and any student with symptoms such as coughing, runny noses and headaches are being sent home. Please also let the school know immediately if anyone in your household is tested for COVID-19 as the school is required to report all tests to an internal incident reporting line. We will need to know when your child was tested and where. Please also contact the school with the results of the test. We so appreciate your support with this process.

As you would be aware the border between NSW and Victoria closed as of 12:01am 8 July 2020. All staff and students returning from Victoria after this time must have a permit to enter NSW and are required to self-isolate for a period of 14 days. With the exception of staff and students who reside in a border town, all other staff and students who have been in Victoria in the 14 days before the commencement of school should not attend school until they complete the 14 days self-isolation period since they left Victoria. NSW Health has requested anyone who has been in Victoria and is unwell or has flu like symptoms arrange to be tested through their local medical practitioner or one of the COVID-19 clinics. Please assist us by notifying the school if any of these are relevant to you.

Finally, I would like to say that I am looking forward to meeting our students and families over the coming weeks and months and am really looking forward to a fun and fabulous term of learning.
