The Year 6 Farewell is almost upon us! This note is to advise you how things will run on the night so that you can organise your timing.

The night will start at 5:30pm.

Year 6 Parents:

Following the latest COVID safe practice advice from the Department of Education, we can now invite **Year 6 parents** in at the start of the evening if they wish to take photos. No siblings or extended family will be permitted to come through the gates with you. Year 6 parents will need to sign in at our COVID station, situated at the hall entrance gate. Proof of double vaccination will need to be sighted.

Year 6 parents will need to leave the grounds when the students enter the hall. They are then invited to return to join us in the hall at 7.40pm to see their child receive their graduation medal and presentation bag.

Year 5 Parents:

To follow the Department guidelines, we ask that Year 5 parents only enter the school at the <u>end of the evening</u>. At that time, they should enter via the main gate and assemble to the left of the Koala steps in the carpark to wait for their child.

Conclusion of the evening:

*If the weather is fine, all students will leave via the main gate in the teacher carpark. If it is raining, all students will leave via the gate nearest the hall.

	All families are asked to leave the carpark as soon as the last students have passed
	under the bell.
