Is your child a keen Leura Public School mathematician and problem solver? This year, we are excited to offer students in Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 the opportunity to compete in the Australian Mathematics Competition (AMC).

The AMC is one of Australia's largest and most highly respected educational events. Designed by Australia's leading educators and academics, the competition is comprised of 30 engaging mathematical problems aimed at inspiring students to become great problem solvers. The AMC has been held every year since 1978 and more than 15 million students from Australia and overseas have taken part.

The AMC will be held at Leura Public School on **Friday 5**th **August 2022** via the Australian Maths Trust's online competition platform. The cost for participation per student is **\$7.50**. After the competition, students will receive a certificate, information on how they performed and what they can do next to continue to build their problem-solving skills.

AMC Training Sessions

Students in Years 5 and 6 will prepare and train for the AMC during in-class mathematics lessons. Participating students in Year 4 will have the opportunity to partake in a 2-hour training session on Tuesday 26th July 2022. This session will include:

- Introduction to the AMC guidelines, competition structure, time management and equipment list
- Being an AMC mathematician problem solving strategies and mathematical comprehension skills

Australian Maths Trust – Privacy and Consent Information for parents and carers

In 2022, Leura Public School will be participating in the Australian Maths Trust's (AMT) **Australian Mathematics Competition (AMC)**. This is a voluntary competition, so your child's participation is not mandatory.

Participation

At Leura Public School the competition will be held via the AMT competition platform. Personal information about your child, including their first and last name, date of birth, gender, school and school year will be recorded in AMT's online platform.

AMT also publish the results of its competitions and activities on its website, and may include information such as the student's name, school, school year, state, award and score as well as the names of award winners and/or medalists.

AMT has advised that the personal information is kept in their competition servers which are physically located in Australia, however they use an online provider platform based in the Netherlands for competition processing and analysis. Back-up servers are located in the Netherlands. AMT deliver the competition, and use the personal information, in accordance with the AMT's Privacy Policy. What you need to do

As per the Australian Privacy Principles, if you want your child(ren) to participate in the competition above, you need to provide your consent by completing the school permission note. Your child can participate under an alias if you prefer. This means the school will only provide AMT with the alias and the results will be attached to this alias. *Please note that students who undertake the competition using an alias will not be able to receive a certificate from the AMT*.
