## **Penny Whistle Group 2022**

Dear Parents and Carers,

Your child has expressed interest in learning Penny Whistle as part of our school's extra-curricular music program. We would like to confirm that you support your child to borrow a school instrument, practice at home, look after the instrument and bring it along to group lessons at school. **There is no fee to be involved in this program.** 

The Penny Whistle (also known as Tin Whistle) is a traditional Irish instrument, similar to the recorder, but somewhat easier for beginners. Group lessons are as follows:

- Wednesday Recess: Stage 2 (Years 3 and 4)
- Monday Recess: Stage 3 (Years 5 and 6)
