We want our students to enjoy making music with friends, building camaraderie and a strong sense of accomplishment as part of our school band program.

During 2025, the school will be using an external provider Mr. Peter Earl, The Music Guy, to coordinate, organise and conduct the school band and tuition program for students (Years 3-6) learning musical instruments at Leura Public School. Mr. Peter Earl, an experienced primary school teacher until 2021, now runs concert band programs throughout the Greater Western Sydney Area. Peter was recently nominated for an ARIA Music Teacher Award for his innovative approach to engaging young minds through concert band programs that incorporate body percussion, theatrics, and games.
