
Congratulations 🞉 Exciting News for Mr. Steve Atkinson

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#### The Premier's Spelling Bee 2022

The Premier's Spelling Bee is open to all NSW government primary, central and community schools. We have entered Leura Public School into the competition this year. The competition comprises of two divisions – junior for Years 3 and 4 and senior for Years 5 and 6. Year 2 are invited to participate in the junior division. At regional finals, each school can enter one student per division to a maximum of two students per school.



Each Stage 2 and 3 class and Year 2 combined will hold a class Spelling Bee towards the end of this term. Students from each class competition will be invited to participate in the junior and senior school division competition on Tuesday the 26<sup>th</sup> of July. From this competition one junior and one senior student will be selected to participate at the regional finals.


